PRESIDENTS NIGHT



THE ROAD TO ZERO-EMISSION CONTAINERSHIPS

Veer, a maritime startup based in The Bahamas, is gearing up to select a shipyard for the construction of its groundbreaking wind-powered containership, as reported by Offshore Energy.

The innovative solution from Veer combines wind propulsion with auxiliary fuel cell propulsion using green hydrogen as fuel and DynaRig sails. The company's inaugural ship design, named 'Design N°1', promises to be the first absolute zero-emission containership capable of ocean crossings.

With a secured €50 million Letter of Intent (LOI) to fund the design and construction, Veer has received bids from five reputable European shipyards and is poised to announce the chosen shipyard in the coming weeks.

The European Maritime Safety Agency (EMSA) has recognized 'Design N°1' as an exemplary vessel for two industry studies focused on wind and hydrogen propulsion, underscoring Veer's commitment to cutting-edge sustainable shipping solutions. In conjunction with these developments, Veer is launching a Series A investment round, inviting investors to participate in revolutionizing the shipping industry. Veer's initial fleet comprises 100-meter containerships powered by hydrogen fuel cells and wind propulsion, aiming to provide a swift and eco-friendly container shipping service. This initiative addresses the challenges faced by the shipping sector in reducing emissions.

In a significant milestone, Veer received Approval in Principle (AiP) from the American Bureau of Shipping (ABS) in October 2022, reinforcing the feasibility and potential impact of its zero-emission ship project.
